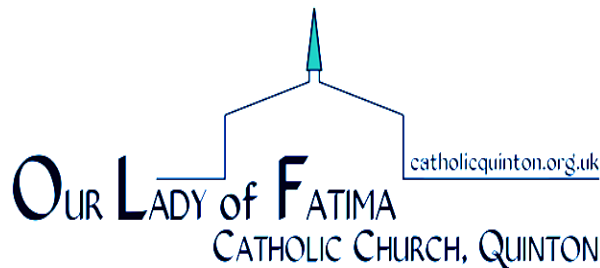

3. Debit Cards. Use the contactless card terminal now situated in the church porch and tap your card.

4. Planned giving. If you prefer to make offerings using cash it is helpful to use the planned giving or gift aid envelopes. This gives you privacy and you can set aside a sum of money each week.

GIFT AID IT! For those who are tax payers, **Gift Aid** can easily be applied to any of the 4 methods listed above. This means that for every £1 you donate, the parish (as a registered charity) receives an additional 25p in reclaimed tax from the Government at no cost to you!
