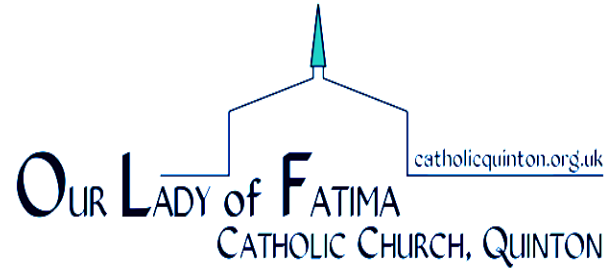

PARISH BBQ

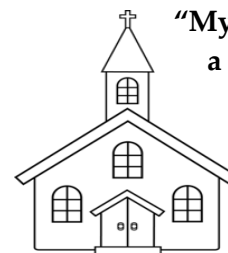
